



# APPLICATION, REGISTRATION AND RENEWAL FEES

## **CIRCULAR NO. 12 OF 2016: APPLICATION, REGISTRATION AND RENEWAL FEES**

In terms of Section 51 of the National Credit Act, 2005 (NCA) as amended, the Minister may prescribe application, registration and renewal fees by registrants.

Notice No. 514, Government Gazette No. 39981, wherein the Minister of Trade and Industry, Dr Rob Davies, published the final Regulations on the determination of application, registration and renewal fees after inviting public comments to the draft regulations on the determination of application, registration and renewal fees, was issued on 11 May 2016.

The Minister has also determined **31 July** as the new date for the renewal of registration for all registrants. The NCR has commenced with a process to align all registrants to the **July** date.

Further please take note that in terms of the said Notice, penalty fees will be charged for any late renewal of registration in terms of Section 51(1)(d).

Whilst the NCR sends the notices of annual renewal of registration to registrants, it remains the responsibility of each registrant to monitor due dates of renewal and comply with this provision timeously.
